CALLING ALL URINE MARKING AND SPRAYING CATS!

Our hospital is currently enrolling cats to participate in a pilot clinical study to evaluate the effectiveness and safety of an investigational veterinary product for the management of feline behavioral urine spraying.

Your patient may be eligible for participation if he or she:

- 1. Is spraying vertical surfaces with urine an average of 3 times per week.
- 2. Is spayed or neutered and is at least 1 year old
- 3. Is the only cat in your household spraying urine, and there are no more than 3 cats in your household.
- 4. Is housed indoors (screened in patios are OK).
- 5. Is not currently receiving medication to manage pain, anxiety or urine spraying behavior.

Cats that are part of the study will receive at no charge:

- 1. 3 evaluations over 5 consecutive weeks.
- 2. Study medication or placebo
- 3. 2 physical examinations
- 4. Screening labwork twice over 5 consecutive weeks
