The FVMA is assisting the AVMA to identify a member veterinarian who will serve on the site team that will visit City College. Volunteers are asked to attend a 2-day on-site visit to the program, read through the program self-study report, and assist in developing a report of evaluation. Travel, food, and lodging expenses incurred in connection with the site visit are reimbursed; however, honorariums are not paid.



# New Oncology Tid Bits

Hope they new year brings new and great things for all of you. Now that the 2020 is behind us, let hope for better things to come. In this newsletter article, I will like to share some of the new things in oncology.

First is the a new treatment for Mast Cell Tumors. Stelfonta is a new injection of a new chemical (tigilanol tiglate) found in the seed of the Australian native blushwood plant (*Fontainea picosperma*). This drug has been approves to treat cutaneous mast cell tumor is dogs of less that 10 cubic centimeter or subcutaneous located below the elbow or hock. Baseline research shows promising results. The pilot study was a randomized, blinded, control field clinical trial with 123 dogs with stage Ia or IIIa cutaneous or lower limb subcutaneous MCT confirmed by cytology. Dogs were randomized with 81 receiving drug and 42 controls. In addition dogs receive corticosteroids, H1 & H2 blockers. Out of the dogs treated with Stelfonta, 75% (60/80) achieved complete resolution at day 28 vs. 5% (2/38) in control dogs. A second dose of Stelfonta in 18 dogs that did not achieve complete remission at day 28 increase the overall response to 87%.

Further research was performed on the dogs that had achieve response. They monitor 74 dogs for 12 months and 88% (60 dogs) were still in remission. Only 9 dogs had disease progression and 8 achieved complete response after another dose.

As you can see there is a lot of excitement with this medication, as soon as it becomes available we at [Pet Cancer Group](#) will have it available as well.

Another new tool now available is a chemotherapy sensitivity assay for lymphoma. With this new technology we can predict the effectiveness of multiple drugs for each specific dog. By collecting live lymphoma cells, they not only provide the same previously available flowcytometry results, but they also provide drug sensitivity to at least five different chemotherapy drugs. This is now available at Pet Cancer Group and we are using it more and more to help our clients and us make better treatment decisions.

The final thing I wanted to share with you is a new study recently publishes that looks at the effects of altering dogs and the risk and benefits by breed. This is a question that is frequently ask by owners and unfortunately there is no good research to answer it. I hope this article help you answer that questions in your daily routine. ## Microchipped Dog Reunited with Family After 6 Years!



Six years ago, the Vasquez family of San Antonio, TX had their beloved Chihuahua mix King stolen from their backyard in TX. Posters were made, a reward offered, and posts made on social media but King was nowhere to be found. On Sunday, October 25 a woman surrendered King to the Humane Society of Broward County because she was ill and could no longer care for him. She told the admission's staff she only had the dog for six months and got him from his previous owner. Upon his clinic examination, Humane Society staff scanned the 10

pound dog to see if there was a microchip and thankfully there was. After calling the chip company, and learning King had been reported missing, the rightful owner was contacted who was in shock when she found out King was more than 1,300 miles from his home. It turns out King is 15 years old!

The Vasquez family, left Texas on Monday and drove more than 1,300 miles – 19+ hours – to be reunited with King. There were many tears and hugs and the family is grateful they have King home where he belongs. They never gave up hope. The local media shared this story and it has since aired worldwide. Just this week a reporter with a news outlet in Japan reached out to cover the reunion.

If your hospital scans a lost pet and is able to reunite the pet with the rightful owner, especially after many years, you too should contact the local media. Hopefully it will encourage all pet owners to have their pets microchipped. This is an essential way to prove ownership and help reunite lost pets. Also remind them to keep the contact information up-to-date if they pet owner moves.
